To whom it may concern,

I as Gordon Builders, Inc. have worked with Erich Gerber and his company GSMetallic-Atlanta, for about 7 years. Our first job in 2004 was East Decatur Station, where he produced something in the range of 400 feet of steel rail for us, keeping up the pace and producing quality work. He helped us think out an economical system, then produced swiftly.

We have done a number of smaller jobs together with good results.

In 2006 We renovated the Inman Alley building on Krog st., which included extensive structural steel alterations, several different forms of lintels in masonry walls, a number of steel accessories for the loft style finishes inside, and extensive hand rail for entry stairs and loading dock.

Three years ago we took on the renovation of the Jane, on Memorial drive, an adaptation of several buildings for reuse. This was a complex steel job, wherein Eric had to build structural steel from underneath existing loads. It could have been quite dangerous if we had not had a good crew of steady hands from G. S. We drove the pace very hard during the period when railings were being build, and Erich responded well on short notice and delivered quality work at a good pace. Every flight of stairs in the project was different, all had to be measured for custom parts, and very little needed to be adjusted to fit. Most of the work dropped right into place with very little marring of the finished walls they were mounting to.


Our next project was the Red Voght garage at Spring and Linden, in which we again built new structure inside as we cut the floors of the building. Erich's crew produced well under very difficult working conditions. Again they built both the structural steel and the ornamental railings.

In spite of the customer presenting serious obstacles to completion, Erich's team gave us steady support and helped us bring the job to a conclusion.
